Section IX. Preventive measures	
Protective clothing in	Safety glasses, protective gloves and garments, eye washer and
case of spill and leak	safety shower if needed.
Spill and leak	Ventilate and evacuate area. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment as specified above. Avoid contacting eyes. Avoid breathing vapour, contacting liquid. Shut off source of the leak only if it is safe to do so. Sweep up and containerize for reclamation or disposal. Collect as much of the spilled material as possible, place the spilled material into a suitable disposal container. Keep spilled material out of sewers, ditches and bodies of water.
